2. Summarize your top takeaways from the message.
3. Jesus calls Satan “*a liar and the father of lies*” (John 8:44). Paul tells us that Satan “*masquerades as an angel of light*” (2 Corinthians 11:14-15). What are some of the characteristics of a believable lie? When is a lie not believable?
4. 1 Peter 5:8 tells us that Satan is out to destroy. He is “*like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.*” A common way Satan destroys and devours is by getting people to waste their lives, by being consumed with the wrong priorities or things that won’t last. What are some examples?

**Question:** Which of these do you struggle with?

5. Read Ephesians 6:10-13. What does this passage reveal about our situation and our responsibility?

**Question:** The phrase “take your stand” is a military expression that refers to a posture of opposition toward an enemy. If you know your enemy is going to attack by lying to you and trying to get you to waste your life, what does it look like to take your stand?
