John lists seven poetic descriptions to reveal Jesus: His clothing identifies Him as a priest, the head and eyes reveal He is pure and purifies, the feet symbolize that He is a solid foundation, His voice drowns out all others, the right hand symbolizes control, His mouth reveals His weaponry which is His Word, and His face symbolizes His blessing.

- What might be some examples of daily living based on John's vision?
