*Phlegon*, AD 140, in the Olympiads (quoted later)

## What do these writings confirm?

- Jesus
  - ◇ Performed miraculous feats
  - ◇ Was

    - ◆ Crucified
      - Under Pontius Pilate
      - On the eve of Passover
- Jesus' followers believed He was the Messiah
- Christians worshipped Jesus as God
