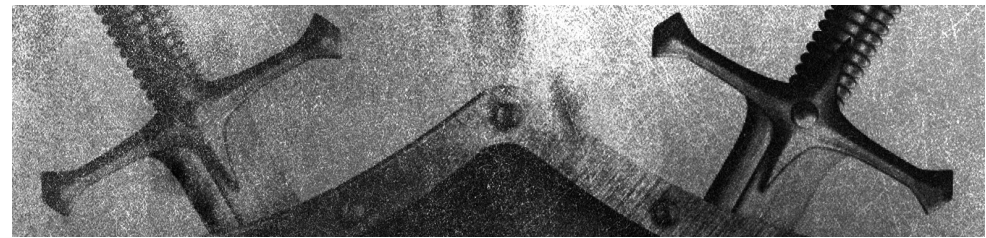

Courageous Love, Part 1

2. What is something you had to do that required courage?

4. Bevan explained how courageous love is more action than emotion, and more practice than promise. What do you think of these two points? How do these differ from our normal understanding of love?

5. Read John 13:1-11. If you were in Jesus' situation, what emotions do you think you would have been experiencing? What circumstances would have made it tough to love?

- What are some situations in your life where it is difficult to show love? What makes it difficult?

6. Read Romans 5:1-8. What does this passage say about love?

- As you have understood and experienced God's love, how has this impacted your love toward others? Are there any specific changes?

7. Real love doesn't occur in the big moments when you get to do something huge; it occurs in the little moments when you get to practice love again and again. What are some little practices of love you can do this week?
