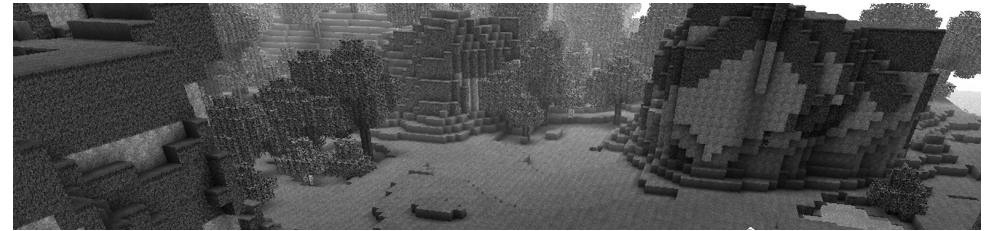

## **Growth Group Homework – May 8, 2016**

### **How to Make a World of Difference: Amazing Grace**

In part two of “How to Make a World of Difference,” Bevan explained the four-part process to accept God’s grace. It starts with us hitting the bottom, then letting go, showing up, and giving thanks. Due to our tendency to ignore our need for grace, God will use this process to remind us so we can make a world of difference.

#### **Warm-Up**

1. When have you ever felt, “My whole life just passed before my eyes?”  
What happened?

2. What part of your story would people find hard to believe?

#### **Talk it Over**

3. What part of this week’s message stood out to you and why?

4. Read Luke 15:11-32. How do you see the four-part process of receiving God’s grace in this passage?

- How do you think the younger brother’s experience of receiving grace would have impacted his future actions?

5. Read 2 Corinthians 12:8-10. Often we think God only uses A+ type people. What in this passage challenges that idea?

- How has God used an area of weakness in your life? Explain.

6. Bevan explained that, “You cannot speak honestly about something you have not experienced in your own life. So, God will let us experience our need for grace so we will extend it to others.” How have you experienced this?

7. In the face of weakness or failure, we want to run; however, when we keep showing up to do what is right, God delivers his grace. What has been your experience in this area?

- Where do you need to keep showing up? What does this look like for you?

#### **Bring it Home**

8. Read Jonah 2:8-9. Bevan explained how “white knuckles” are an indication that something is an idol. Where is an area of life that you have “white knuckles,” and what would it look like to let go of it?

- In what way have you recently received God’s grace? How could you be intentional about showing gratitude for His grace?
